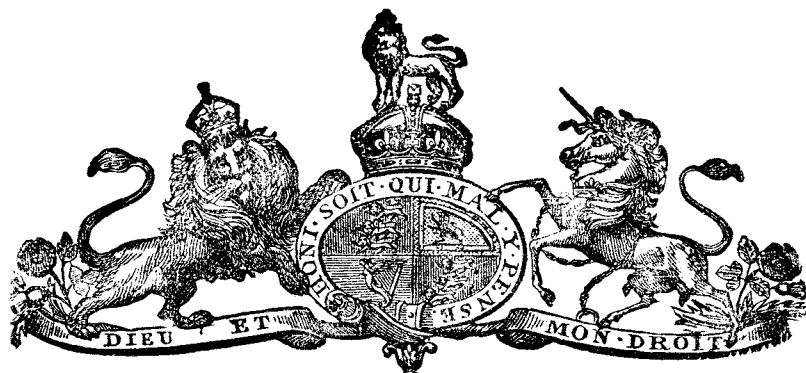

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Loans (Flotation Expenses) Act (No. 1), 1927.”

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to appropriate and apply, for the purposes mentioned in the schedule to this Act, the sum of Twenty-three thousand six hundred and twenty-three Pounds Seven Shillings and Threepence, such sum comprising the moneys in this section hereunder mentioned.
