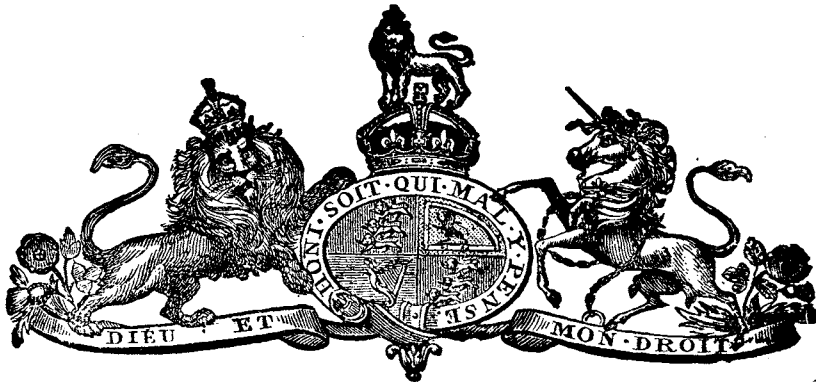

AN ACT to make provision for Meeting the Discount and Expenses in connection with the Borrowing of certain Moneys by the State. [24 December, 1929.]

A.D. 1929.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Loans (Flotation Expenses) Act, Short title 1929.”

2 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate a sum of Twenty thousand five hundred and nineteen Pounds Two Shillings and Eight Pence, authorised by the State Steamships Purchase Act, 1920, and raised under the Loans Act (No. 3), 1920-21, and to apply the same in payment of the discount payable and the expenses incurred in connection with the raising of loans authorised by Parliament up to the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
