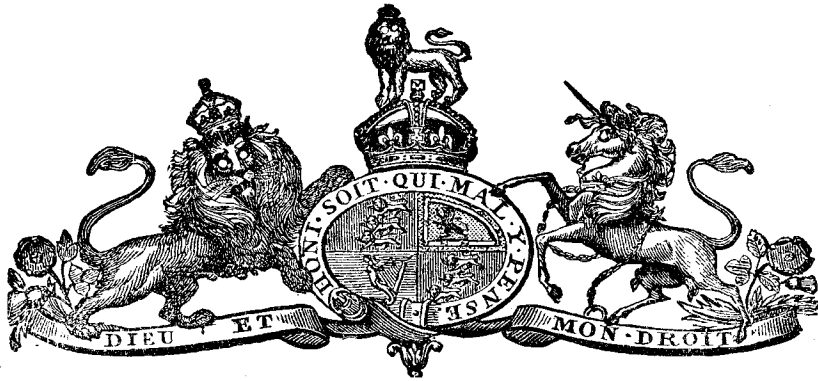

AN ACT to make provision for meeting the Expenses incurred in connection with the borrowing of certain Moneys, and for other purposes. A.D. 1927.
[17 December, 1927.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

V. No. 37, and raised under the Act 11 Geo. V. No. 44.
