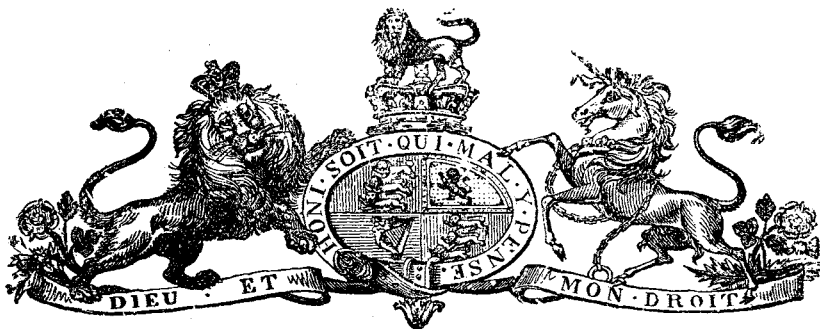

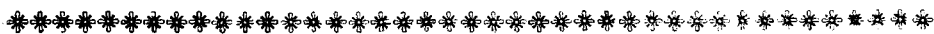

AN ACT to further amend "The *Launceston* A.D. 1893.
Electric Light Act, 1887."
[14 November, 1893.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend, in the manner herein-
after appearing, "The *Launceston* Electric Light Act, 1887": PREAMBLE.
Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *Launceston* Electric Light Act, Short title.
1893."

2 In this Act, unless the context otherwise determines, the expression Interpretation.
