

AN ACT to amend the 51 Victoria, No. 43, A.D. 1890. "The Launceston Electric Light Act." [28 November, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to extend certain provisions of "The PREAMBLE.

Launceston Electric Light Act," hereinafter referred to as "the said 51 Vict. No. 43.

Act":

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Electric Light Short title. Amendment Act."
 - 2 Section 59 of the said Act is hereby repealed.

Repeal.

3 If the Council does not commence operations in a bonâ fide Operations to be manner under the powers conferred upon it by the said Act within the commenced period of Two years from the First day of January, 1891, this Act within Two years.

and the said Act shall cease and determine.

4 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as Acts read together.
