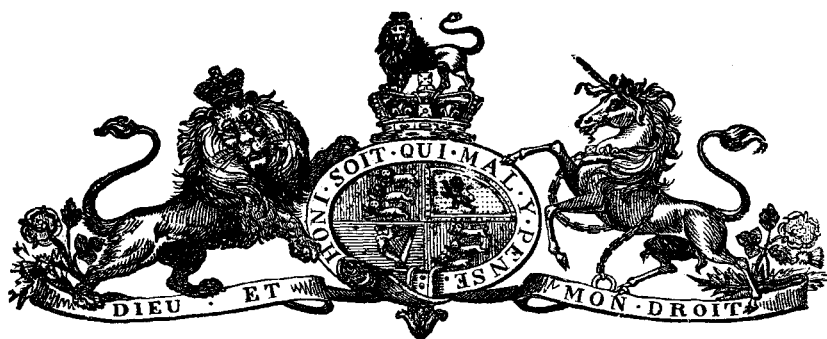

AN ACT to amend the 51 *Victoria*, No. 43, A.D. 1890.
“The *Launceston* Electric Light Act.”
[28 *November*, 1890.]

WHEREAS it is desirable to extend certain provisions of “The *Launceston* Electric Light Act,” hereinafter referred to as “the said Act”: PREAMBLE. 51 Vict. No. 43.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited as “The *Launceston* Electric Light Amendment Act.” Short title.
- 2 Section 59 of the said Act is hereby repealed. Repeal.
- 3 If the Council does not commence operations in a *bonâ fide* manner under the powers conferred upon it by the said Act within the period of Two years from the First day of *January*, 1891, this Act and the said Act shall cease and determine. Operations to be commenced within Two years.
- 4 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts read together.
