AN ACT to authorise the Reappropriation of certain Unexpended Balances of Loan Moneys and the Application thereof for the purposes of making provision for certain State Liabilities and to provide for the Adjustment of the Accounts of the Treasury relating thereto. [23 December, 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Loan Funds Adjustment Act' Short title. 1930."

Repeal.

2 The several enactments enumerated in Schedule (1) hereto are hereby repealed to the extent specified in the third column of the said schedule.

Reappropriation of amounts in Schedule (2).

3 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to reappropriate and apply for the purposes of this Act the several sums set forth in Schedule (2) hereto out of the respective balances of the amounts authorised by or raised under the Acts specified in that schedule and not required for the purposes thereof respectively, or representing repayments of moneys applied under such Acts, as the case may be, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Six hundred and sixteen thousand three hundred and fifty-two Pounds and Two Pence.

Application of existing sinking funds.

- 4—(1) As soon as practicable after the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, the State Sinking Fund Commissioners shall transfer to the Treasurer the several amounts set forth in the third column of Schedule (3) hereto, representing the several sinking funds held by the said Commissioners in relation to the respective accounts against which such amounts appear in the said schedule, with interest up to the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and thirty, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of One hundred and sixty-five thousand and sixty-four Pounds Fourteen Shillings and Eight Pence.
- (2) Every such amount as aforesaid shall be credited in the books of the Treasury to the account in relation to which the particular sinking fund which it represents was established.

Application of moneys reappropriated.

5 The Treasurer, upon receipt of the amounts mentioned in Section Four hereof, shall apply the moneys reappropriated under this Act for the purpose of balancing the several accounts standing in the books of the Treasury which are enumerated in Schedule (3) hereto by crediting to such accounts, respectively, the amounts indicated in the fourth column of that schedule, and thereupon the said accounts shall be closed; and all payments required by any Act to be made or credited in respect of the said accounts, or any of them shall cease, and shall be deemed to have ceased, to be payable as from the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty.

Adjustments.

6 The Treasurer and the said Commissioners may cause such transfers and entries as he and they respectively may consider necessary or desirable to be made in their respective books for the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of this Act.
