

A.D. AN ACT to amend "The Local Government 1911. Act (Tramways), 1907." [10 January, 1912.]

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 This Act may be cited as "The Local Government Act (Tram- Short title and ways), 1911," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The incorporation Local Government Act (Tramways), 1907," in this Act referred to as with 7 Ed. VII. No. 49. the Principal Act.
