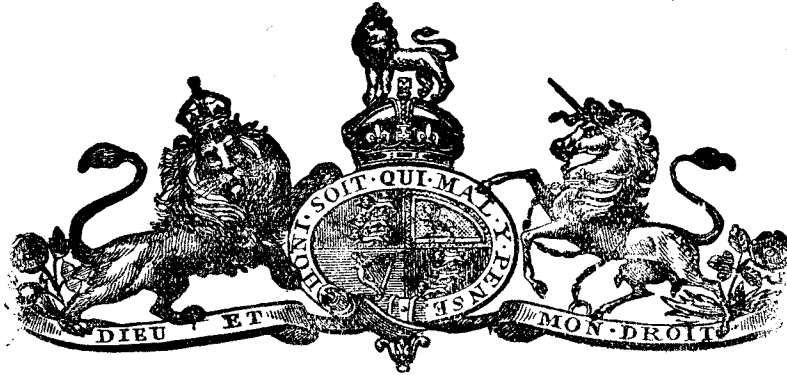

AN ACT to amend "The Local Government Act (Tramways), 1907." A.D. 1911.

[10 January, 1912.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Local Government Act (Tramways), 1911," and shall be incorporated and read as one with "The Local Government Act (Tramways), 1907," in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and incorporation with 7 Ed. VII. No. 49.

**2** Section Five of the Principal Act is hereby amended by inserting the words "recording their votes at such poll" immediately after the word "aforesaid" occurring in line Three, Amendment of Section 5 of Principal Act.
