AN ACT to amend "The *Launceston General Hospital Act, 1878.*" [9 October, 1882.] A.D. 1882.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 Upon the commencement of this Act, the Three Honorary Medical Officers of the *Launceston General Hospital* shall cease to be Members of the Board of Management of the said Hospital; and so much of Section Five of "The *Launceston General Hospital Act, 1878,*" as provides that Three Members of the said Board shall be Honorary Medical Officers, and the Second Clause of the Ninth Section of the said Act, shall be hereby repealed, but this repeal shall not affect any thing duly done thereunder before this repeal. Repeal of portions of 42 Vict. No.15.

2 Within One month after the commencement of this Act the Governor in Council shall, by Notice in the *Gazette*, appoint Three fit and proper persons to be Members of the said Board. Appointment of Three Members of the Board.

3 The said Act as amended by this Act, and this Act, shall be read and construed together as one Act. Acts to be read together.

4 This Act may be cited as "The *Launceston General Hospital Act, 1882.*" Short title.
