

AN ACT to amend "The Longford Lighting 1909 Act, 1903," and for other purposes. 3 Ed. VII. No. 44. $[30 \ November, 1909.]$

WHEREAS by Section Ninety-eight of "The Longford Lighting PREAMBLE. Act, 1903," it is enacted that the power to borrow the sum of Three 54 Vict. No. 31 thousand Pounds under "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," for the purpose of carrying out the objects of the firstmentioned Act, shall be exercised in accordance with and subject to the provisions of "The Local Bodies Loans Act," with the exception of certain specified 45 Vict. No. 16. sections of that Act:

And whereas the Trustees of the Longford Light District have not strictly complied with the provisions of "The Local Bodies Loans Act" as to advertisements, and the resolutions passed by the said Trustees for borrowing the said sum of Three thousand Pounds are not effective;

And whereas it is desirable that the said resolutions should be validated, and that the Governor should be empowered to grant the said loan to the said Trustees:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and incorporation. 3 Ed. VII. No. 44.

1 This Act may be cited as "The Longford Lighting Act, 1909," and shall be incorporated with and construed as one with "The Longford Lighting Act, 1903," hereinafter called the Principal Act.

Power to £3000 to the Trustees. 54 Vict. No. 30.

2 It shall be lawful for the Governor to grant, in accordance with Governor to lend the provisions of "The Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890," and any Act amending the same, the sum of Three thousand Pounds as a loan to the Trustees of the Longford Light District to enable them to carry out the objects of the Principal Act.

Resolutions validated.

3 The resolutions for borrowing the sum of Three thousand Pounds, passéd by the said Trustees, are hereby declared to be legal and valid and may be adopted by them, and the said Trustees may forthwith, without further authority, exercise the power to borrow conferred upon them by Section Ninety-seven of the Principal Act.

Repeal of Section 98 of Principal Act.

4 Section Ninety-eight of the Principal Act is hereby repealed as from the commencement of that Act.
