PREAMBLE.

WHEREAS it is expedient to alter the name of the Launceston Mechanics' Institute and Public Library to that of the Launceston Public Library, and to reduce the number of members of the Board of Management of the Institute from twenty-six to sixteen;

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Mechanics' Institute and Public Library Incorporation Act, 1929."

2 The Launceston Mechanics' Institute and Public Library Incorporation Act is hereby amended—

- I. By deleting from the fourth and fifth lines of Section Two thereof the name "The Launceston Mechanics' Institute and Public Library" and substituting therefor the name "The Launceston Public Library":
- II. By deleting from the fourth line of Section Five thereof the words "four" and "twenty" respectively and substituting therefor the words "two" and "twelve" respectively:
- III. By deleting from the second line of Section Fifteen thereof the word "seven" and substituting therefor the word "five."
