

AN ACT to amend the Lending of Money Act, 1915. A.D. 1932.  
—  
[23 December, 1932.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Lending of Money Act, 1932.” Short title.

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended by deleting the words “one hundred” in the third line of Section Four thereof (inserted by the Lending of Money Act, 1925) and in the eighth line of Section Five thereof, respectively, and substituting in each case the word “fifty”.
