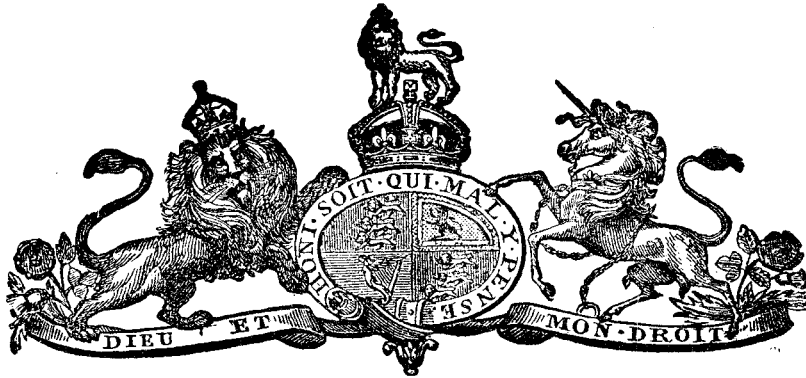

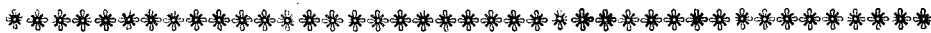

AN ACT to amend "The Legal Practitioners Act, 1896." A.D. 1924.
[23 December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Legal Practitioners Act, 1924." Short title.

(2) "The Legal Practitioners Act, 1896," is herein called "the Principal Act." Principal Act.

Qualification for
 articled clerks.

2 Section Eight of the Principal Act is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor :—

“**8** No person shall be articled to a practitioner unless and until such person has attained the age of sixteen years, and has—

i. Matriculated in the University of Tasmania : or

ii. Passed in such subjects as may be prescribed—

(a) Such Public Examination of that University as may be prescribed : or

(b) Such other examination as may be prescribed as equivalent to such Public Examination.”

Amendment of
 Section 19 of the
 Principal Act.

3 Section Nineteen of the Principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—

i. By inserting in the second line thereof after the word “articled” the words “persons who hold or have held any of the following offices :”

ii. By deleting the word “Ten” in the second line of Paragraph i. of the proviso to the said section and substituting the word “Five” therefor : and

iii. By deleting the words “Subsection ii. of” in the second line of Paragraph ii. of the said proviso.
