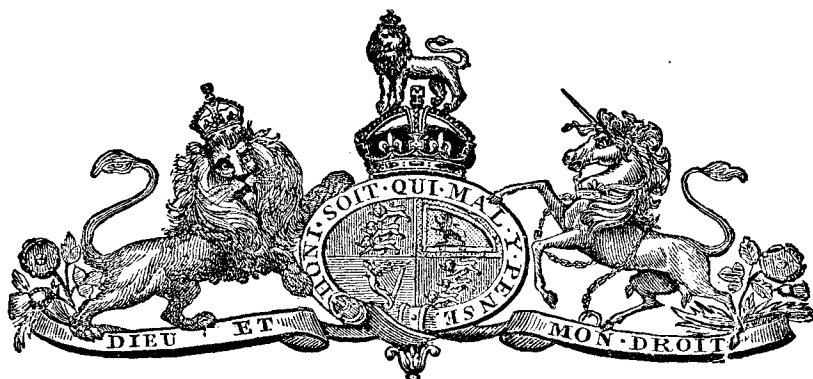

AN ACT to amend the Legal Practitioners Act, 1896. [18 January, 1930.]

A.D. 1929.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Legal Practitioners Act, 1929.” Short title.

2 After Section Fifteen of the Legal Practitioners Act, 1896, the following new section is inserted :— Amendment of 60 Vict. No. 43.

“ 15a Subject to the provisions of this Act, service in any State of the Commonwealth in accordance with the law there in force under articles to a person entitled during the whole of the term of such service to practice in that State as a solicitor or a barrister and solicitor may be reckoned as part of the service under articles required by this Act.” New Section 15a. Service under articles in another State.
