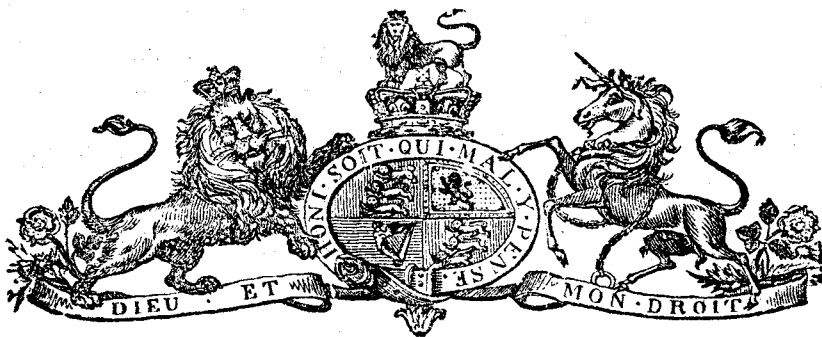

AN ACT to amend "The Local Public Works
Act, 1867." [18 October, 1870.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend "The Local Public Works Act, 1867:" Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

PREAMBLE.

1 "The Local Public Works Act, 1867," is hereinafter referred to as the principal Act. Reference to

2 Whenever any District under the principal Act is desirous of constructing a Bridge or Breakwater under the provisions of the said Act, and the provisions of the said Act have been in all other respects complied with, the Rate mentioned in the Ninth Section of the said Act may be of such an amount as will pay, as nearly as may be, interest on the amount raised by the sale of Debentures for such Bridge or Breakwater at the rate of Three Pounds per centum per annum, clear of all deductions in respect of costs of collection and otherwise, anything in the said Section to the contrary notwithstanding. When a District desires to erect a Bridge or Breakwater Rate may be reduced.

3 Out of any moneys to be set apart under the 99th Section of "The Waste Lands Act," it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to appropriate annually a sum of money equal to the amount Appropriation from Road Fund in aid of work.

Local Public Works Amendment.

of the Rate collected for the payment of interest upon the money raised by the sale of Debentures for constructing any Bridge or Breakwater under the provisions of this Act and the principal Act; but such sum of money shall not in respect of any work exceed in any one year Three Pounds per centum upon the amount collected by any such rate.

Acts to be read together.

4 This Act and the principal Act shall, save as altered or amended by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act.

Short Title.

5 This Act may be cited as "The Local Public Works Amendment Act."
