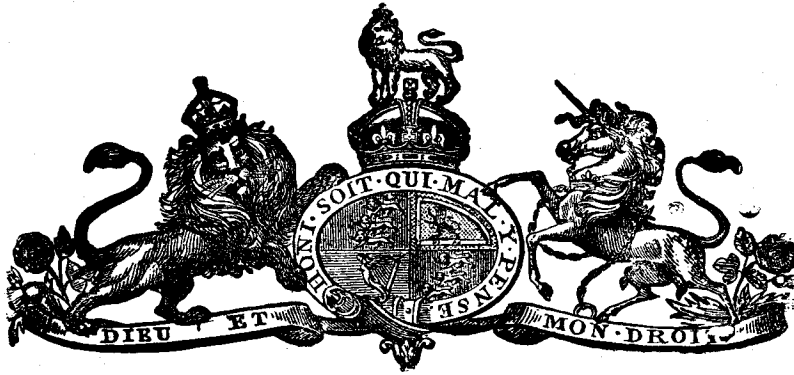

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title and incorporation.
2. Amendment of Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend the Act 4 Edwardi VII. ^{A.D.} 1916.
No. 23, intituled "An Act to amend 'The
Local Public Works Loans Act, 1890.'"
[29 January, 1916.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1—(1) This Act may be cited as "The Local Public Works Loans Amendment Act, 1916," and shall be incorporated and read as one with the Act 4 Edwardi VII. No. 23, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act. Short title and incorporation.

(2) The Act 4 Edwardi VII. No. 23 may be cited as "The Local Public Works Loans Amendment Act, 1904."

2—(1) The Principal Act is hereby amended as follows :—

i. As to Section One thereof—

(a) By omitting the word “Six,” occurring in the Fifth line thereof, and substituting therefor the word “Seven”:

(b) By inserting immediately after the word “determine,” occurring in the Sixth line, the words “and the Governor may, in his discretion, from time to time, revise the rate of interest so fixed, and again fix and determine the same;”

ii. As to Section Two thereof, by omitting the First Five lines thereof, and substituting therefor the following :—

“2 The interest to be so paid by the Public Body may from time to time be fixed and determined by the Governor at such a rate as to only include and cover—

i. Interest at the rate for the time being payable by the State : and ”

(2) The amendments made by this section shall have a retroactive operation.
