

3. Governor authorised to acquire land, &c., on terms of agreement.

AN ACT to ratify an Agreement, made 1924. between the Premier and the Prime Minister of the Commonwealth, for the Purchase by the State from the Commonwealth, of certain Land and Buildings, situate in the City of Hobart, and certain Plant and Equipment, and for other purposes. [31 March, 1924.]

HEREAS, in or about the month of December, One thousand PREAMBLE. nine hundred and twenty-two, the Premier, on behalf of the State, entered into an agreement (hereinafter called "the said agreement") with the Prime Minister of the Commonwealth for the purchase by the State from the Commonwealth, as at the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, of certain land and buildings situate at the corner of Harrington and Melville streets in the City of

Land (Repatriation School) Purchase.

Hobart, some time since used by the Commonwealth for the purpose of a school for the technical and vocational training of repatriated soldiers and sailors, for the sum of Six thousand five hundred Pounds, and also for the purchase, as at the lastmentioned date, of the plant and equipment, previously used in connection with the said school, for the sum of Five thousand Pounds, such land, buildings, plant, and equipment being required for the purposes of a technical school in connection with the Education Department:

And whereas by the said agreement it was agreed between the Premier and the Prime Minister that the said respective sums of Six thousand five hundred Pounds and Five thousand Pounds, making in all the sum of Eleven thousand five hundred Pounds, should be set off pro tanto, as at the said date, against the moneys payable by the Commonwealth to the State, in respect of the property of the State vested in or acquired by the Commonwealth under Section Eighty-five of

"The Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act."

63 and 64 Vict. c. 12.

And whereas it is expedient to ratify the said agreement, and to authorise the Governor, on behalf of the State, to acquire the said land and buildings and the said plant and equipment in accordance with the terms thereof:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title,

1 This Act may be cited as "The Land (Repatriation School) Purchase Act, 1924."

Ratification of agreement.

2 The said agreement is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Governor authorised to acquire land, &c., on terms of agreement,

- 3 It shall be lawful for the Governor on behalf of the State-
 - 1. To acquire from the Commonwealth the said land and buildings and the said plant and equipment in accordance with the terms of the said agreement:
 - of the said sum of Eleven thousand five hundred Pounds, as at the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-two, against the moneys payable by the Commonwealth to the State in respect of the property of the State vested in or acquired by the Commonwealth under Section Eighty-five of "The Commonwealth of Australia Constitution Act."
