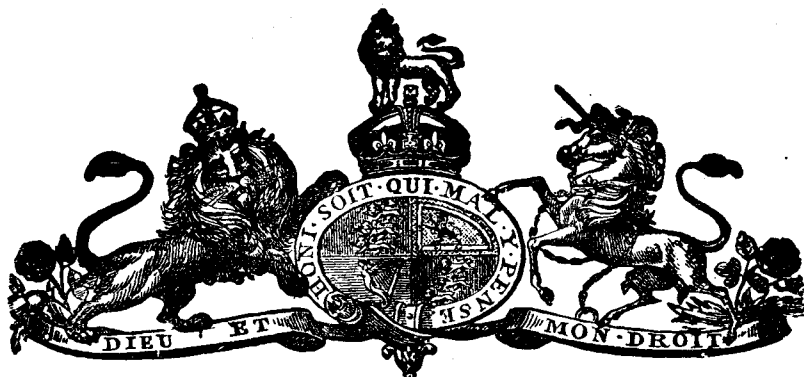

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Extension of operation of 14 Geo. V. No. 34.

AN ACT to amend the Liquor Tax Act, 1924. A.D. 1929.
[25 October, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Liquor Tax Act, 1929.”

Short title.

2—(1) The operation of the provisions of Section Seven of the Liquor Tax Act, 1924, is hereby extended up to and including the thirtieth day of January, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.

(2) The provisions of Subsection (1) hereof, and of any section hereafter enacted in similar terms, shall be read and construed as though the quarterly days corresponding to the quarterly days enumerated in Section Seven aforesaid for the delivery of returns thereunder were thereby specifically inserted in that section in respect of the period for which the operation of the provisions of that section is or shall be extended thereby.
