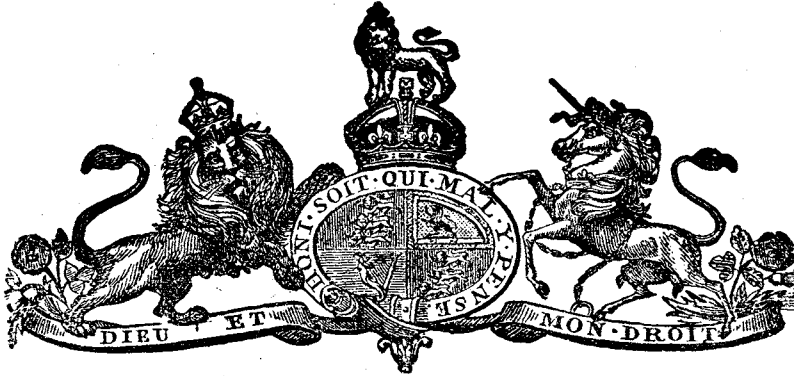

AN ACT to further amend "The Land Vesting Act, 1894." [21 September, 1921.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Land Vesting Act, 1921," and shall be read and construed as one with "The Land Vesting Act, 1894" (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act), and any amendment thereof.

Short title and incorporation with 58 Vict. No. 17.

2 Whenever the Minister for Works is authorised or empowered to undertake, construct, or provide any public work being or involving the making or construction of a drain, and to acquire land for or in connection with such making or construction, all the provisions of the Principal Act shall apply, *mutatis mutandis*, to the acquisition of such land. Provided that land acquired for such purpose as aforesaid shall not become a public highway as is provided in the Principal Act with respect to land acquired under the provisions thereof for roads.
