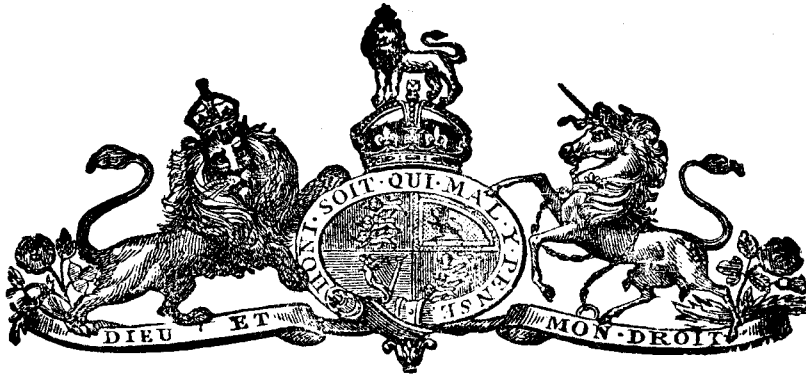

AN ACT to further amend the Launceston <sup>A.D.</sup> 1929  
 Water and Light Act, 1895.  
 [24 *December*, 1929.]

**BE** it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Launceston Water and Light Act, Short Title, 1929.”

**2** Section One hundred and sixteen of the Launceston Water and Light Act, 1895, is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby inserted in lieu thereof—

“ **116** The Council shall not make more than one-half of the usual charge for water supplied under this Act to the institutions following, that is to say—

The Launceston General Hospital,  
The Home for Invalids, Mulgrave-street,  
The Men's City Mission, Wellington-street,  
The Girls' Home, Wellington-street,  
The Salvation Army Retreat, Connaught-crescent,  
The Launceston Benevolent Society's Office, Kingsway.  
The Homœopathic Hospital.  
The Queen Victoria Hospital.”
