AN ACT to further amend the Launceston 1929
Water and Light Act, 1895.

[24 December, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Launceston Water and Light Act, Short litle, 1929."

### Launceston Water and Light.

### A.D. 1929.

Repeal and re-enactment of Section 116 of 58 Vict. No. 31.

2 Section One hundred and sixteen of the Launceston Water and Light Act, 1895, is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby inserted in lieu thereof—

"116 The Council shall not make more than one-half of the usual charge for water supplied under this Act to the institutions following, that is to say—

The Launceston General Hospital,

The Home for Invalids, Mulgrave-street,

The Men's City Mission, Wellington-street,

The Girls' Home, Wellington-street,

The Salvation Army Retreat, Connaught-crescent,

The Launceston Benevolent Society's Office, Kingsway.

The Homœopathic Hospital.

The Queen Victoria Hospital."
