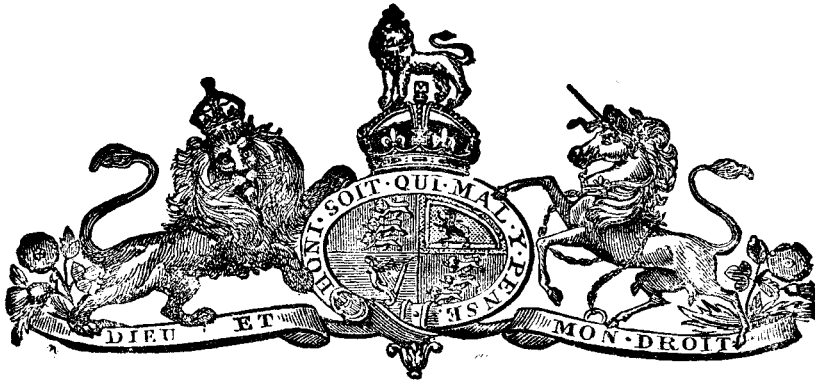

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Marine Act, 1926.”

Short title

2 The Marine Act, 1921, is hereby amended —

Section 28.

1. As to Section Twenty-eight thereof by deleting the word “seven” from the first line thereof, and substituting therefor the word “eight”;

Section 29.

II. As to Section Twenty-nine thereof by inserting after the word "district" where it first occurs in the second line thereof the words "one by the electors of the Penguin Voting District":

Section 158.

III. As to Section One hundred and fifty-eight thereof, by expunging therefrom Paragraph 1. thereof: and

Schedule (4).

IV. As to Schedule (4) thereof, by deleting therefrom all the words in the fifth, sixth, and seventh lines thereof, and substituting therefor—

"The Emu Bay Voting District comprises the Municipality of Emu Bay.

"The Penguin Voting District comprises the Municipality of Penguin, excluding therefrom that portion thereof which is included in the Leven Harbour Trust Voting District."

Council of Municipality of Penguin to pay over Jetty Account funds.

3 Upon the passing of this Act the Council of the Municipality of Penguin shall pay to the Marine Board of Burnie all moneys in the hands of such Council to the credit of an account known as "The Penguin Jetty Account" or held by such Council for the purposes of such jetty.
