

AN ACT to further amend "The Master and A.D. 1887. [31 August, 1887.] Servant Act, 1856."

 \mathbf{B} E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :---

1 In this Act the expression "the said Act" means "The Master Interpretation. and Servant Act, 1856," and every Amendment thereof. 19 Vict. No. 28.

2 In all proceedings before a Justice or Justices under the said Act, the Defendant a Defendant shall in all cases be competent but not compellable to give competent evidence, anything contained in any law or practice to the contrary witness. notwithstanding.

3 The said Act, as amended by this Act, and this Act, shall be read Acts to be read and construed together as one Act.

4 This Act may be cited as "The Master and Servant Act, 1887." Short title.
