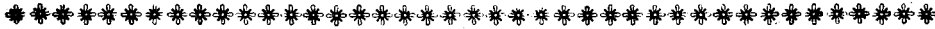

AN ACT to further amend "The Marine Board Act." A.D. 1887.
[20 December, 1887.]

WHEREAS doubts have arisen as to the power of Marine Boards under the existing Acts to pay any sum of money as a gratuity to the Widows of Officers or Servants of the Boards : PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 It shall be lawful for any Marine Board, out of the funds at their disposal, to pay any sum of money as a gratuity to the Widow or Children of any deceased Officer or Servant of such Board : Provided that the approval of the Governor in Council shall be obtained before any such payment is made as aforesaid. Marine Boards may pay gratuity with the approval of the Governor in Council. 26 Vict. No. 16.

2 This Act may be cited as "The Marine Board Amendment Act, Short title. 1887."
