

AN ACT to further amend "The Marine A.D. 1887. Board Act." [20 December, 1887.]

W HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the power of Marine Boards PREAMBLE. under the existing Acts to pay any sum of money as a gratuity to the Widows of Officers or Servants of the Boards:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 It shall be lawful for any Marine Board, out of the funds at their Marine Boards disposal, to pay any sum of money as a gratuity to the Widow or may pay gratuity Children of any deceased Officer or Servant of such Board: Provided of the Governor that the approval of the Governor in Council shall be obtained before in Council. any such payment is made as aforesaid.
