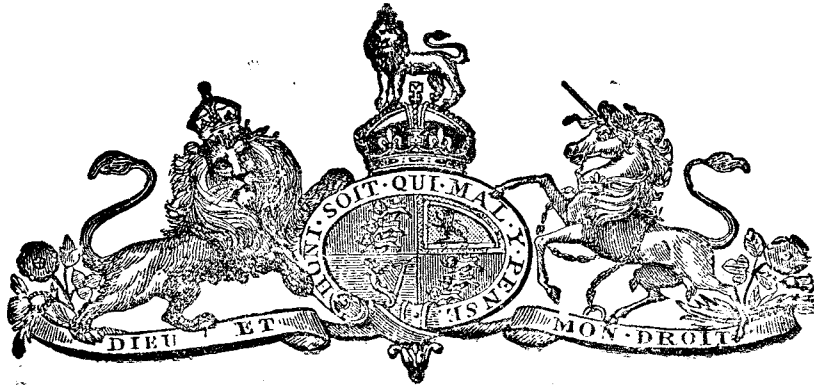

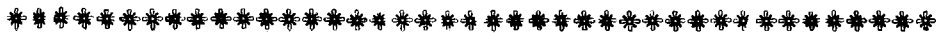

AN ACT to amend the Mining Companies Act, 1884. A.D. 1929.
[18 January 1930.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania; by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Mining Companies Act, 1929.” Short title.

2 Section One hundred and twelve of the Mining Companies Act, 1884, is hereby amended by expunging Paragraph iii. thereof, and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

“ iii. The salary or wages of any manager, clerk, miner, or servant of the company, actually due in respect of services rendered to the company during the period of four months immediately preceding the commencement of the winding up: such salary or wages shall have priority over any mortgage or charge or any other encumbrance over or affecting the assets of the company or any of them and all other debts of the company. £ s. d.’
