

AN ACT to further amend "The Mount 1910. Cameron Water-race Act, 1887." [25 August, 1910.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Mount Cameron Water-race Short title. Amendment Act, 1910," and shall be read and incorporated with 51 Vict. No. 28. "The Mount Cameron Water-race Act, 1887," and the Acts amending the same.

2 In this Act "the said Act" means "The Mount Cameron Water- Interpretation. race Act, 1887," and "the Board" means the Mount Cameron Water-race Board.

Mount Cameron Water-race.

Repeal and re-enactment of Section 8 of 51 Viet. No. 28.

- 3 Section Eight of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the following section substituted therefor, namely:—
- "8 The Board shall consist of Six members, of whom the Secretary for Mines, the Warden of Mines for the district in which the water-race is situated, and the Chief Inspector of Mines for the time being shall be Three, and the remaining Three members shall be appointed annually by the Governor by notice in the 'Gazette'; and one of the members to be so appointed shall be appointed to represent the purchasers of water supplied by means of or from the water-race, and shall be one of such purchasers.
 - "Every member shall hold office during the Governor's pleasure."

Amendment of Section 9 of 51 Vict. No. 28. 4 Section Nine of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the word "Two" occurring in line Four, and inserting the word "Three" in lieu thereof.
