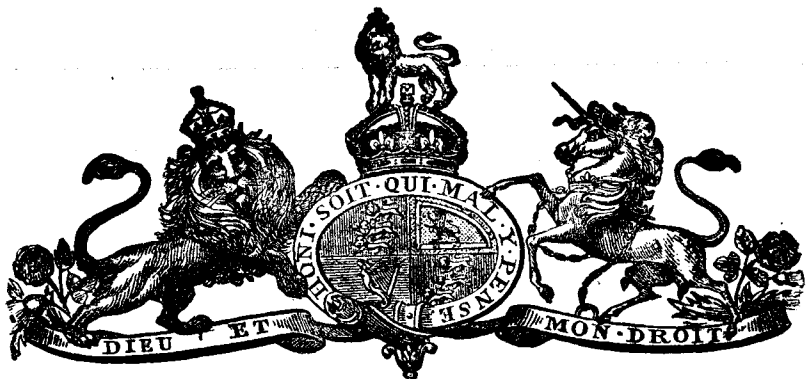

AN ACT to further amend "The Mount ^{A.D.} 1910.
Cameron Water-race Act, 1887."
[20 *December, 1910.*]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Mount *Cameron Water-race* Short title. Amendment Act (No. 2), 1910," and shall be read and incorporated with 51 Vict No. 28, "The Mount *Cameron Water-race Act, 1887,*" and the Acts amending the same.

Interpretation.

2 In this Act—

“The said Act” means “The Mount *Cameron* Water-race Act, 1887:”

“The Board” means the Mount *Cameron* Water-race Board.

Amendment of
Section 14 of

3 Section Fourteen of the said Act is hereby amended by inserting after the word “Water-race,” in the Fourth line thereof, the words “For providing for payment to be made from time to time out of the revenues of the Board to the members of the Board or any of them of sums of money by way of allowances or travelling expenses.”
