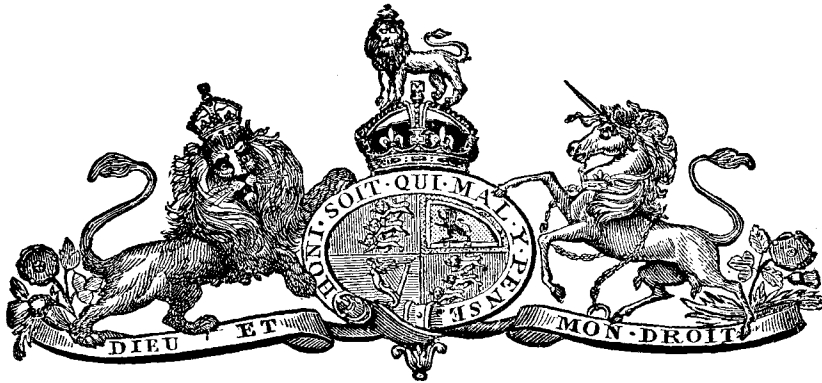

ANALYSIS.

1. Short title.
2. Further sum of £1000 may be expended for completion of water-race.

AN ACT to amend "The Mount Cameron Water Race Act, 1887." [2 December, 1922.] ^{A.D.} 1922.

WHEREAS under and by virtue of "The Mount Cameron Water Race Act, 1887" (hereinafter called "The Principal Act"), the management and control of the water-race mentioned in the Principal Act, and all rights and property therein, and in the water flowing along the said water-race, were, subject to the provisions of the Principal Act, vested in the Board constituted under that Act, and provision was made in the Principal Act for completion of the said water-race : PREAMBLE.

And whereas since the said completion, and previously to the year One thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, various sums of money were appropriated by Parliament for the purposes of extending and improving the said water-race, and such sums of money have been expended for such purposes :

And whereas, under and by virtue of "The Public Works Execution Act, 1921," the Minister for Works was authorised to cause to be constructed a deviation of the said water-race at a cost of Seven thousand seven hundred Pounds, and such construction is now being proceeded with :

And whereas the further sum of One thousand Pounds will be required to be expended to complete such construction as last aforesaid :

And whereas it is desirable that the extensions of the said water-race heretofore constructed, and the deviation thereof now being constructed, should be subject to the management and control of, and be vested in, the Board :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as the "The Mount Cameron Water Race Act, 1922."

Further sum of £1000 may be expended for completion of water-race.

2—(1) It shall be lawful for the Minister for Works to cause to be completed the construction of the deviation of the water-race referred to in the Preamble to this Act, at a cost not exceeding the sum of One thousand Pounds.

(2) The provisions of "The Public Works Execution Act, 1921," shall apply to the work authorised, and the sum voted by Subsection (1) hereof to the like extent as if such work had been authorised and such sum voted by the lastmentioned Act.

Water-race vested in the Board under the Principal Act to include extensions and deviation thereof.

3—(1) The water-race, the management and control whereof were vested in the Board by virtue of the Principal Act, shall, for the purposes of such Act—

i. Be deemed to include all extensions thereof the cost of the construction of which was defrayed out of moneys appropriated by Parliament for that purpose, and to have so included such extensions as from the respective dates of such construction : and

ii. Be deemed to include the deviation thereof, now being constructed and completed under the provisions of "The Public Works Execution Act, 1921," and this Act, when so constructed and completed.

Mount Cameron Water Race.

(2) All rights and property in the said extensions and deviations and in the water flowing along the same, shall, subject to the provisions of the Principal Act and as hereinafter mentioned, vest in the Board in like manner as the water-race referred to in the Principal Act, and all rights and property therein and in the water flowing along the said water-race were vested in the Board at the commencement of this Act.

4 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the Principal Act, all land which has been acquired or which shall hereafter be acquired for the purposes of the said water-race, or any extension or deviation thereof, shall vest in His Majesty.
