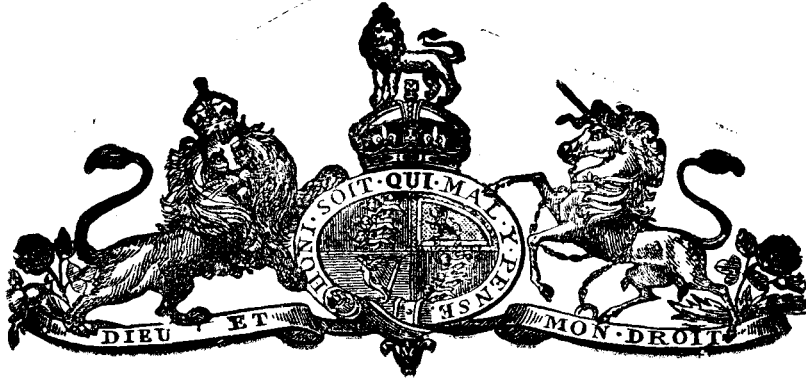

AN ACT to amend the Mental Deficiency Act, 1920. [25 July, 1929.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited as “The Mental Deficiency Act, 1929.”
- 2 Section Thirty-nine of the Mental Deficiency Act, 1920, is hereby amended—
  1. By expunging Paragraph 1. of Subsection (2) thereof, and Section 39, substituting therefor the following new Paragraph 1. :—
    - “1. The Director of Public Health or such other medical officer of the Department of Public Health as the Governor may appoint” ;
