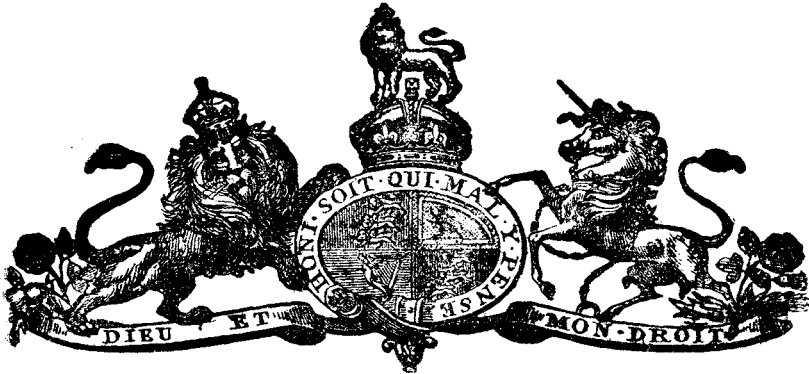

AN ACT to amend the Mount Dundas and Zeehan Railway Act. [22 November, 1932.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

2 The Mount Dundas and Zeehan Railway Act Amendment Act is hereby amended by repealing Section Eight and substituting therefor the following section :—

“**8**—(1) The Minister, with the approval of the Governor, may grant to the said Company renewals of any leases granted under the said Act or this Act, for any term not exceeding twenty-one years.

“(2) The power of the Minister to grant renewals of any such leases shall include power to vary or suspend the conditions thereof in relation to the maintenance of train services, but in all other respects any renewals of such leases shall be upon, and subject to, all the conditions herein prescribed, and all the provisions of the said Act and this Act, so far as the same may be applicable, shall apply to any renewals of such leases.”.
