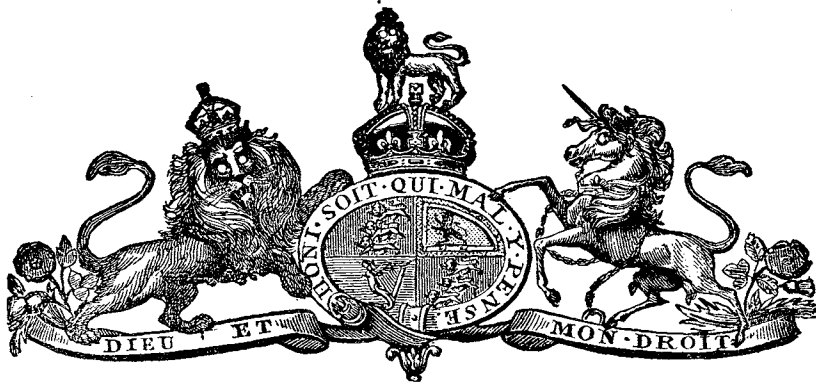

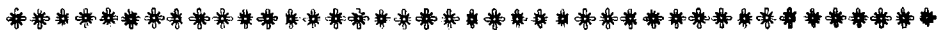

AN ACT to amend the Mental Diseases Hospitals Act. [8 December, 1926.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

2 The Mental Diseases Hospitals Act is hereby amended by inserting therein after Section Thirty-nine thereof the following new section **39a** :—

“ **39a** In addition to the powers conferred by Section Thirty-nine hereof on the Supreme Court or a judge thereof, such court or judge, in any of the cases mentioned in that section, may make orders for the application of any moneys belonging to any such insane person as in that section mentioned, whether arising from real or personal estate, and whether income, accumulated income, or capital, for or towards the maintenance of such person ; or of the husband or wife of such person ; or for the maintenance, education, clothing, or advancement of the children or grandchildren of such person ; or, in the event of the death of such person, for the payment of the expenses of his burial.”
