# AN ACT to amend the Meat Industry Encouragement Act, 1929. [2 October, 1931.]

A,D. **1931.** 

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Meat Industry Encouragement Act, 1931."

2 The Meat Industry Encouragement Act, 1929, is hereby amended-

Electors.

New Section 7.

- I. By repealing Section Seven thereof and substituting therefor the following new Section Seven—
  - "7 Every sheepowner, who, on the thirty-first day of December next before the date on which an election of district members is held, was the owner of not less than thirty sheep and who has made a return as provided by Section Nineteen, shall be an elector and shall be entitled to one vote at such election.":

Section 18.

- II. By inserting after Subsection (3) of Section Eighteen thereof the following new Subsection (4) -
  - "(4) No such contribution as aforesaid shall be payable in respect of any year after the year one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one.":

Section 19.

III. By expunging therefrom Subsection (5) of Section Nineteen thereof: and

Section 20,

IV. By deleting from the second line of Subsection (2) of Section Twenty thereof the words "not exceeding two months" and by expunging Subsection (3) of the said Section Twenty."

A uthority for Board to pay certain moneys.

Grant of £4000 to Board.

3 It shall be lawful for the Board to pay out of any moneys at its disposal any costs incurred by the Board in relation to any legal proceedings taken against the Board or which the Board has agreed to pay upon the compromise of any such proceedings.

4-(1) There shall be granted out of the Consolidated Revenue to the Board a sum of Four thousand Pounds for the purposes of this Act.

(2) The said sum of Four thousand Pounds shall be paid and applied by the Treasurer in liquidation of all amounts heretofore advanced by the Governor to the Board by way of loan under this Act.
