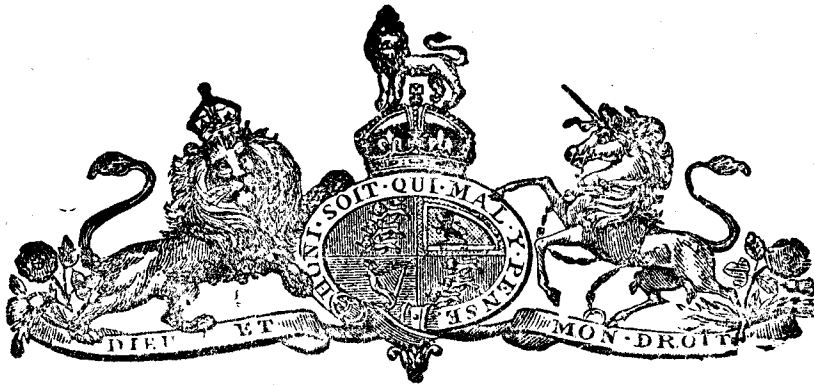

AN ACT to amend the Meat Industry  
Encouragement Act, 1929.

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as "The Meat Industry Encouragement Act, 1932."

**2** The Principal Act is hereby amended—

I. By repealing Section Seven and substituting therefor the following new Section Seven :—

“7— (1) Every sheepowner who has—

i. Made a return of sheep dipped as required by the Stock Act, 1932, in respect of the period from the first day of October to the thirty-first day of March immediately preceding the date of an election under this Act : or

ii. During the period mentioned in Paragraph i. hereof, has obtained an exemption from dipping as provided by the Stock Act, 1932—

in respect of not less than thirty sheep owned by him shall be an elector and shall be entitled to vote at such election.

“(2) The Director of Agriculture shall cause to be supplied to the Board, not later than the first week in April in each year, a list showing the name and address of every person who has lodged a return, or obtained an exemption, as aforesaid which entitles such person to vote at an election in the year in which such list is supplied.”: and

II. By repealing Section Nineteen thereof.

**3** The Meat Industry Encouragement Act, 1931, is hereby amended by expunging Paragraphs I. and III. of Section Two thereof.
