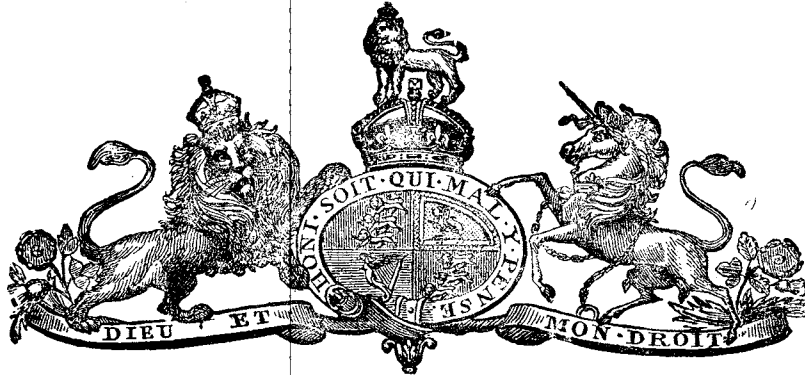

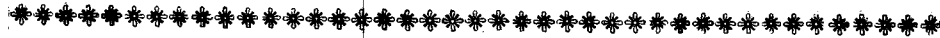

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Malicious Injuries to Property Act, 1910," and shall be incorporated and read as one with the Act 27 *Victoriæ* No. 7, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
