

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Malicious Injuries to Property Short title and Act, 1910," and shall be incorporated and read as one with the Act incorporation 27 Victoriæ No. 7, in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
