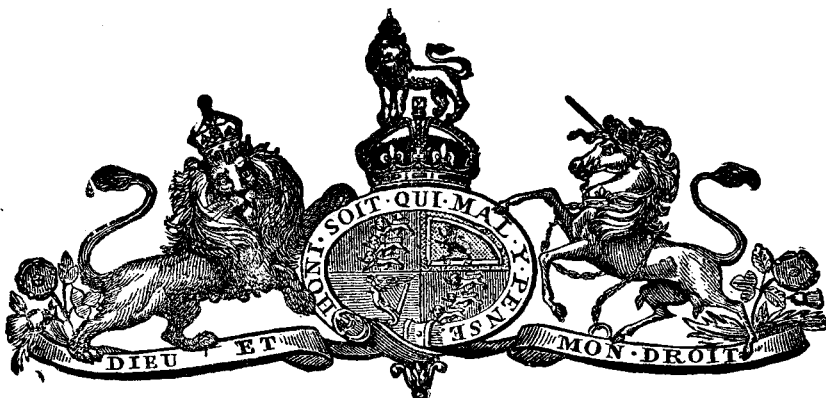

AN ACT to fix the Salaries of the Responsible ^{A.D.} 1910.
Ministers of the Crown.

[20 December, 1910.]

WHEREAS it is expedient to fix the salaries of the responsible PREAMBLE.
Ministers of the Crown :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*,
by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and
House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Ministers’ Salaries Act, 1910.” Short title.

2 From and after the First day of *July*, One thousand nine Sums to be
hundred and ten, there shall be annually paid and applied out of the payable to

Any person who shall, whether in conjunction with any Ministerial office mentioned in the schedule or not, hold the position of Premier, shall be entitled to receive £200 per annum during the time he continues to hold such position of Premier in addition to the salary received by him in connection with such Ministerial office (if any).
