AN ACT to fix the Salaries of the Responsible 1910. Ministers of the Crown.

[20 December, 1910.]

W HEREAS it is expedient to fix the salaries of the responsible PREAMBLE. Ministers of the Crown:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Ministers' Salaries Act, 1910." Short title.
- 2 I'rom and after the First day of July. One thousand nine Sums to be hundred and ten, there shall be annually paid and applied out of the payable to Consolidated Revenue, as the salaries of the persons holding the certain offices.
