AN ACT to amend "An Act to improve the Administration of the Law so far as respects summary Proceedings before Justices of the Peace." [11 December, 1877.] A.D. 1877.

WHEREAS it is expedient and necessary to amend the Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 24th Victoria, No. 5 : PREAMBLE. 24 Vict. No. 5.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 The Act of the Parliament of Tasmania of the 24th Victoria, No. 5, may be cited as "The Magistrates' Stated Cases Act, 1860," and this Act may be cited as "The Magistrates' Stated Cases Act, 1877;" and the said Act and this Act may be referred to as "The Magistrates' Stated Cases Acts, 1860 and 1877." Short title.

2 The period of Three days mentioned in the First Section of "The Magistrates' Stated Cases Act, 1860," as the period within which any party dissatisfied with the determination of a Justice or Justices of the Peace may apply to such Justice or Justices to state and sign a Case as therein mentioned is hereby extended to the period of Ten days after such determination; and the further period of Three days also mentioned in the said Section as the period within which such Case shall be transmitted to the Clerk of the Supreme Court is hereby extended to the period of Five days after the receipt of such Case by the appellant. Periods mentioned in Section 1 of 24 Vict. No. 5, extended.

3 This Act and "The Magistrates' Stated Cases Act, 1860," shall, as altered by this Act, be read and construed together as one Act Acts to be read together.
