ANALYSIS.

Short title and commencement.
 Certain land vested in His Majesty.

AN ACT to revest in His Majesty the King portion of a certain Street in the City of Hobart.

[13 January, 1911.]

WHEREAS the land described in the schedule has heretofore formed the continuation of a public street known as *Macquarie*-street:

And whereas it is now required by the Crown for railway purposes:
Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The *Macquarie* Street (*Hobart*) Short title and Continuation Vesting Act." and shall come into operation on a day to commencement, be fixed by proclamation.

Land Vesting, Hobart.

Certain land vested in His Majesty.

2 The piece of land described in the schedule is hereby vested in His Majesty, his heirs, and successors, and the said piece of land shall henceforth cease to be or form part of any public and common highway or thoroughfare, and may lawfully be enclosed by walls or otherwise, and appropriated to such purposes as His Majesty, or the Governor acting on His Majesty's behalf, shall deem expedient.

SCHEDULE.

CITY OF HOBART.

Bounded on the north-west by 31½ links north-easterly along the Main Line Railway reserve commencing at the south angle of that reserve on Lower Park-street on the south-west by 4 chains 20 links north-westerly in two bearings also along that reserve on the north-east by 72½ links south-easterly crossing the continuation of Macquarie-street on the north-east by 5 chains 46 links south-easterly in two bearings along other portion of the Main Line Railway reserve and thence on the south-west by 1 chain 84 links recrossing the continuation of Macquarie-street to the point or commencement.
