

# AN ACT to amend "The Merchant Ships A.D. 1887. Officers Examination Act, 1878."

[21 *November*, 1887.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Merchant Ships Officers Exami-Short Title. nation Act, 1887," and shall be read as one with "The Merchant Acts to be read Ships Officers Examination Act, 1878," which is hereinafter referred to together. 42 Vict. No. 11. as the said Act.

2 No foreign-going steamship or Australian trade steamship shall No steamship to go to sea from any port unless, in addition to the requirements contained proceed to sea in Section Seventeen of the said Act, every Engineer serving on board such foreign-going or Australian trade steamship shall have obtained Engineers. and possess a valid Certificate either of competency or of service appropriate to his station in such ship, or of a higher grade; and no hometrade steamship shall go to sea from any port unless, in addition to the requirements of the said Section, every engineer serving on board such home-trade steamship shall have obtained and possess a valid Certificate either of competency or service; and every person who, having been engaged to serve as Chief or Assistant Engineer on board any foreigngoing or Australian trade steamship as aforesaid, or as Only Engineer on board any home trade steamship as aforesaid, goes to sea as such

### Merchant Ships Officers Examination.

Chief or Assistant Engineer or Only Engineer without being at the time entitled to and possessed of such Certificate as hereinbefore required, and every Master of any such ship who shall employ any person as such Chief, Assistant, or Only Engineer to serve on board such ship without ascertaining at the time that he is at the time entitled to and possessed of an appropriate Certificate, shall for each such offence incur a penalty not exceeding Fifty Pounds.

Certificate for foreign-going ship or steamship available for home trade ship or steamship. 3 Every Certificate of Competency for a foreign-going steamship or Australian trade steamship shall be deemed to be of a higher grade than the corresponding Certificate for a home trade steamship, and shall entitle the lawful holder thereof to go to sea in the corresponding grade or as Only Engineer in such last-mentioned ship, or to serve in a steam ferry-boat; but no Certificate for a home trade steamship shall entitle the holder to go to sea as Master, Mate, or Engineer of a foreigngoing steamship or Australian trade steamship.
