

AN ACT to amend "The Merchant Ships' Officers Examination Act, 1898." A.D. 1900.
[22 September, 1900.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

- 1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The Merchant Ships' Officers Examination Amendment Act, 1900." Short title.
- 2 In this Act, the expression "the said Act" shall mean "The Merchant Ships' Officers Examination Act, 1898." Interpretation.

- 3 The following words in Sub-section (4.) of Section Fifteen of the said Act are hereby repealed, namely :— "and if the Master of any foreign-going or home-trade ship fails to comply with this provision at the time and in the manner hereby directed, he shall for every such default incur a penalty not exceeding Five Pounds." - 4 Section Twenty-two of the said Act is hereby repealed. Repeal Sect 22,

- 5 This Act and the said Act, save as altered by this Act, shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act. Acts to be read
