

AN ACT to amend "The New Dundas Tram- A.D. 1892. way Company's Act." [28 November, 1892.]

W HEREAS the New Dundas Tramway Company, Limited, have PREAMBLE. commenced the construction of the Railway authorised by "The New 55 Vict. No. 23. Dundas Tramway Company's Act," and have expended certain moneys thereon:

And whereas the said Company have been compelled to go into

liquidation:

And whereas it is expedient to authorise the Governor in Council to grant the Lease mentioned in the said Act to the Liquidator of the said Company, or to a Company formed for the purpose of acquiring the rights of the said Company and to construct, maintain, and work the said Railway:

And whereas it is expedient to extend certain provisions and times

mentioned in the said Act:

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

- 1 This Act may be cited for all purposes as "The New Dundas Short title. Tramway Company's Amendment Act."
 - 2 In this Act—
 "The said Act" means "The New Dundas Tramway Company's 55 Vict. No. 23.

- "The said Company" means the New Dundas Tramway Company, Limited:
- "The said Railway" means the Railway defined in Section Two of the said Act.

Lease may be issued to Liquidator or new Company.

3 It shall be lawful for the Minister, with the consent of the Governor in Council, to grant to the Liquidator for the time being of the said Company, or to any Company formed to the satisfaction of the Governor in Council for the purpose of acquiring the rights of the said Company to construct, maintain, and work the said Railway, the Lease mentioned in the said Act, subject to all the terms, conditions, and stipulations contained in the said Act as amended by this Act.

Provisions of said Act extended.

4 Where before the passing of this Act any enactment contained in the said Act has expired, such enactment is hereby revived; and wherever in the said Act any number or term of years or months are to be computed as from the passing of the said Act, such number or term of years or months shall hereafter be computed as from the date of the passing of this Act: Provided always, that the Lease authorised to be issued by the said Act to the said Company shall only be issued for a term of Twenty-one years from the date of the said Act.

Acts to be read together.

5 This Act and the said Act shall be read and construed together as one and the same Act.
