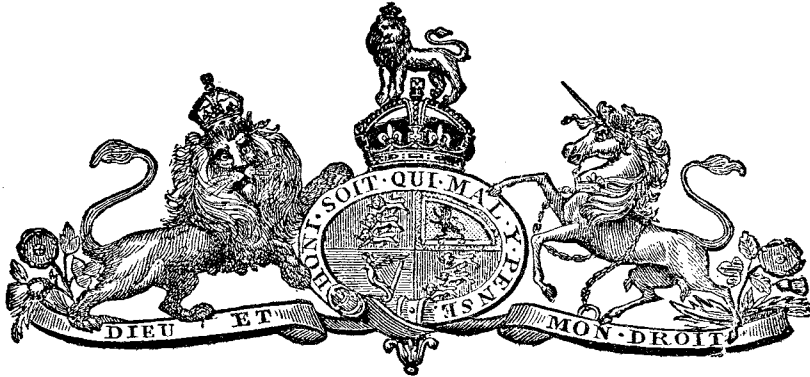

AN ACT to amend the Nurses' Registration Act, 1927. [15 January, 1929.]

A.D. 1928.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

1 This Act may be cited as "The Nurses' Registration Act, 1928." Short title.

2 The Nurses' Registration Act, 1927, is hereby amended by inserting after Paragraph III. of Section Twenty-four thereof the following new Paragraph IIIA.:— Amendment of 18 Geo. V. No. 8, Section 24.

"IIIA. The conditions to be observed by persons practising the calling of midwifery nurses: regulating and controlling the practice of such nurses: and requiring the notification by them, as prescribed, of diseases of the mothers or infants attended by them."
