 - (c) by omitting paragraph (f) of that subsection and substituting therefor the following paragraph:—

Proceedings of the Board. **3** Section ten of the Principal Act is amended by omitting from subsection (2) thereof the word "six" and substituting therefor the word "eight".

TASMANIAN ORCHESTRA (CONTINUATION).

No. 2 of 1966.

AN ACT to amend the Tasmanian Orchestra (Continuation) Act 1951.

[8 June 1966.]

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

Short title and citation.

- 1—(1) This Act may be cited as the Tasmanian Orchestra (Continuation) Act 1966.
- (2) The Tasmanian Orchestra (Continuation) Act 1951, as subsequently amended, is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

State contributions.

- 2—(1) Section three of the Principal Act is amended—
 - (a) by omitting therefrom the numerals "1966" and substituting therefor the numerals "1969"; and
 - (b) by omitting therefrom the words "twelve thousand dollars" and substituting therefor the words "sixteen thousand dollars".
- (2) Paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section shall commence on the first day of July 1966.
