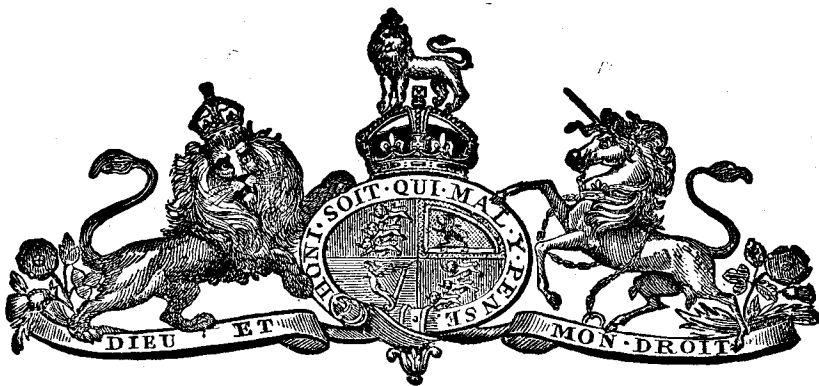

AN ACT to amend the Law relating to <sup>A.D.</sup> 1921.  
Offences against the Person.

[14 February, 1922.]

**B**E it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:—

**1** This Act may be cited as “The Offences Against the Person Act, <sup>Short title.</sup> 1921.”

**2** Any male person who, in public or private commits, or is a party to the commission of, or procures or attempts to procure the commission by any male person of any act of gross indecency with another male person, shall be guilty of a misdemeanour, and shall be liable, upon conviction thereof, to imprisonment for Seven years. <sup>Outrages by male on male.
