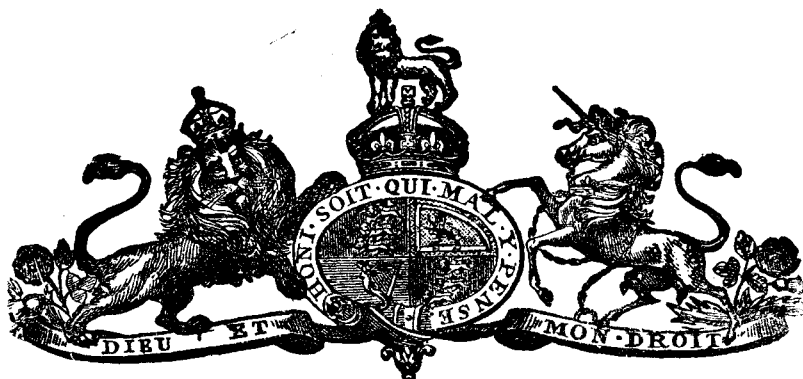

AN ACT to authorise the Loan of Three hundred and fifty Pounds to the Warden, Councillors, and Electors of the Municipality of Oatlands, in accordance with the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921, and for other purposes.

WHEREAS the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Oatlands are desirous of conserving the waters of Lake Dulverton, and for that purpose of obtaining a loan under the provisions of the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921 :

PREAMBLE.

Oatlands Loan.

And whereas the Council has passed special resolutions authorising the said work to be carried out and the sum of Three hundred and fifty Pounds being borrowed for that purpose :

And whereas the said special resolutions were duly confirmed after having been advertised and posted throughout the Municipality of Oatlands :

And whereas a poll of the ratepayers within the area specified in the schedule to this Act was taken at Oatlands on the Fifth day of January, One thousand nine hundred and twenty-five, to decide whether the Council should take the necessary steps to borrow the sum of Three hundred and fifty Pounds for the purpose of carrying out the necessary work, and the question was decided in the affirmative :

And whereas the said resolutions so passed and the poll so held are sufficient for the purposes of this Act :

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Act may be cited as “ The Oatlands Municipality Loan Act, 1925.”

Interpretation.

2 In this Act—

“ The Council ” means the Warden, councillors, and electors of the Municipality of Oatlands :

“ The Rating Area ” means the area shown in the plan to the schedule to this Act, and in such plan surrounded by red lines :

“ The Principal Act ” means the State Loans to Local Bodies Act, 1921 :

“ The Treasurer ” means the Treasurer for the time being of Tasmania.

Power to borrow.

3 It shall be lawful for the Council to borrow under the provisions of the Principal Act upon the security of its revenues any sum or sums of money not exceeding in the whole Three hundred and fifty Pounds for the purpose of defraying the cost and expenses of and incidental to carrying out the necessary works for raising the waters of Lake Dulverton an additional two feet above the former level, and defraying the expenses of and incidental to the preparation and passing of this Act.

Sinking fund.

4 The annual contribution by the Council towards a sinking fund in respect of any money borrowed under the Principal Act shall be an amount equal to One Pound per centum of the moneys borrowed.

Power for the Treasurer to borrow.

5 It shall be lawful for the Treasurer to borrow, raise, and receive a total sum not exceeding Three hundred and fifty Pounds for the purposes of this Act.

Oatlands Loan.

6 It shall be lawful for the Council once in every year to make and levy a separate local rate of not exceeding Two Pence in the Pound upon the annual value of all properties within the rating area, as shown by the Assessment Roll in force for the time being, for the purposes of providing for the payment of interest and sinking fund in respect of the said loan. Any such separate local rate shall be made upon and be payable by the person who would be liable to be rated in respect of the properties included in the rating area if such rate were a general rate under the Local Government Act, 1906, and shall be made and recoverable in the same manner as any such general rate.
