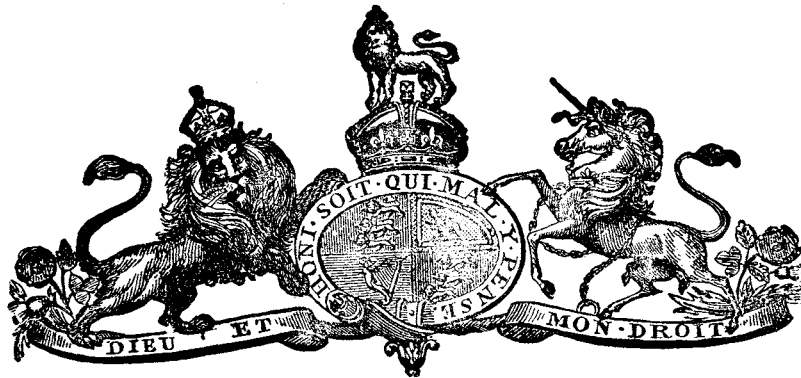

AN ACT to fix the Salaries payable to certain Officers of the Parliament of *Tasmania*. A.D. 1910.
 [20 December, 1910.]

WHEREAS it is expedient that the salaries of those persons who may, from time to time, hold the offices of President of the Legislative Council, Chairman of Committees for the said Council, Speaker of the House of Assembly, and Chairman of Committees for the said House of Assembly, respectively, in the Parliament of *Tasmania* should not be voted annually, but should be fixed and determined by law in manner hereinafter provided : PREAMBLE.

Be it therefore enacted by His Excellency the Governor of *Tasmania*, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows :—

1 This Act may be cited as “The Officers of Parliament Salaries Short title. Act, 1910.”

Officers of Parliament Salaries.

Sums in schedule payable to persons holding offices therein named.

2 From and after the First day of *July*, One thousand nine hundred and ten, there shall be annually paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue, to the respective persons holding the offices named in the Schedule (1.), the respective sums set opposite the names of such offices in the said schedule.

Repeal.

3 The Acts set forth in the Schedule (2.) are hereby repealed, as from the First day of *July*, One thousand nine hundred and ten.
