

AN ACT to fix the Salaries payable to certain 1914. Officers of the Parliament of Tasmania, and [24 July, 1914.] for other purposes.

DE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

- 1 This Act may be cited as "The Officers of Parliament Salaries Short title. Act, 1914."
- 2 "The Officers of Parliament Salaries Act, 1910," is hereby Repeal of 1 Geo. repealed as from the Thirtieth day of June, One thousand nine hundred V. No. 41, and fourteen.

Officers of Parliament Salaries.

A.D. 1914.

Additional payments authorised in respect of period from 1st January to 30th June, 1914.

3—(1) There shall be paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue in respect of the period commencing on the First day of January, One thousand nine hundred and fourteen, and ending on the Thirtieth day of June. One thousand nine hundred and fourteen, by way of addition to the sum paid or payable under the Act hereby repealed for that period in respect of each of the offices named in the schedule to this Act a sum of Twenty-five Pounds.

(2) Where any of such offices has during the said period been held by more than One person, the sum of Twenty-five Pounds payable under this section in respect of that office shall be apportioned between those persons according to the number of days in the said period

during which they respectively have held the office.

Salaries in schedule payable to persons holding offices therein named. 4—(1) From and after the First day of July, One thousand nine hundred and fourteen, there shall be annually paid and applied out of the Consolidated Revenue to the respective persons holding the offices named in the schedule to this Act the respective sums set opposite the names of such offices in the said schedule.
